A major focus of this Symposium is to facilitate dissemination and discussion of PhD research related to Children and Young People. Participants who may have recently commenced their PhD studies and do not wish to submit an abstract are welcome to register to participate in scholarly discussions and learning opportunities. There is no cost to attend the PhD symposium and attendance is open to both members and non-members of the CRN.

Results/findings (if applicable): If the research is at an advanced stage, participants may wish to discuss their findings and the implications of them. Participants at an early stage of the research process may want to comment on what impact their research findings could make and why their research is important.	
Impact/Outcomes: One sentence identifying the impact of your research for either children or young people (as relevant).
